
What is a School Based Health Center?

- A Health Clinic on the School Campus
- Comprehensive Medical Services
- Mental Health services
- Located on school campus but confidential and separate from school
- Convenient access to health care for students
- Consent from parents per state laws
- Medical providers coordinate with student's Primary Care Provider






Overview: SBHC Sponsors and Partners

Update: Blue Heron/OCEAN Campus SBHC

- Capital project submitted for legislative budget
 - Community and partnership support
 - Requested \$136,000
 - Budget in negotiations; should hear back this week
- Met with BH principal to look at space;
 ideally located for accessibility for OCEAN
 students, and privacy; 10ft x 20ft (small)
- Haven't yet seen remodel proposal yet;
 looking at possibilities with current
 limitations

- Secure funding
- Secure building contractor

Mental Health Needs

Increased Mental Health Services
 Addition of a fourth day of MH services

required remodel of SBHC space to provide

a third, confidential space.

**HRSA grant through Behavioral Health Consortium provided funds for desk, comfortable chair and area rug for new mental health space

DBH Partnership
 Pilot program to help assist students in service enrollment

Diversity Resources - Mental Health
 Ex: Need for BIPOC, Spanish-speaking counselors; Donation received to fund these services






SBHC DOH Grant Funding – 2023-2025

Initially \$220,000 over two years @ \$110,000/year

Receiving an additional \$40,000 for Year 2!

Updated Total: \$260,000 for 2023-2025

- Continue expanded medical services at PTHS
- Continue expanded mental health services at each school
