The purpose of the RCORP Data Sharing CoP is to engage data liaisons from a wide range of community partners (you) to develop processes for enhanced tracking of county level data for substance use disorders and opioid use disorders (SUD/OUD), data analysis, and recommendations that lead to data-informed community-based SUD/OUD initiatives. Data liaisons agree to share SUD/OUD data that support WCSPC initiatives. All data liaisons and stakeholders will have access to this local data to use.
When and Where	Participant Expectations

Members shall share best practices to make the data collection process go smoothly. The coalition staff and/or their consultants will be responsible for updating subawardee data into PIMS as required by HRSA. When local data is updated monthly, then the data will be consolidated and entered into the PIMS worksheet. The Afia data portal will be stronger if data is updated monthly. Members shall agree on the types of data shared on Afia. Members will work to grow the CoP and sustain it for at least three years or longer as funds are available.
