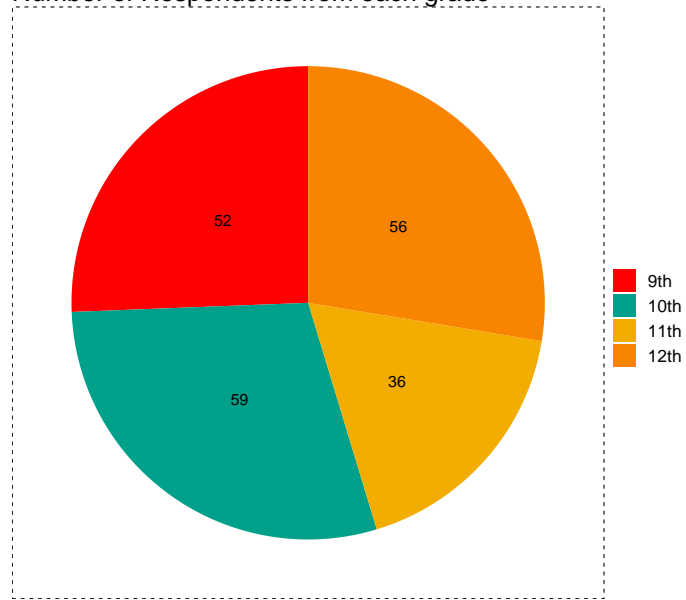
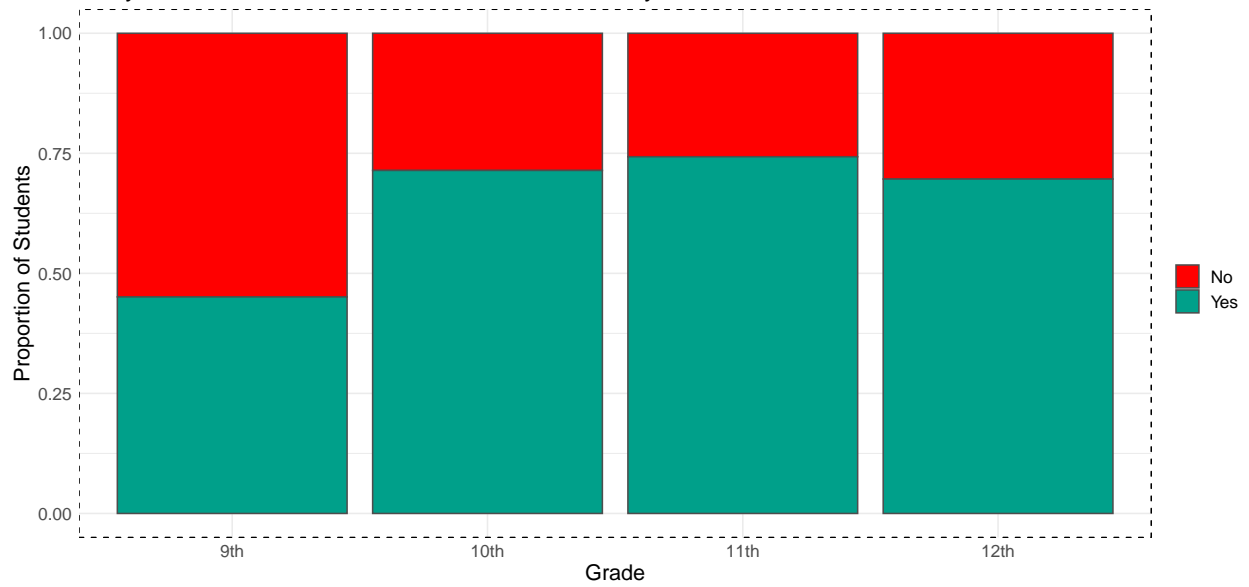

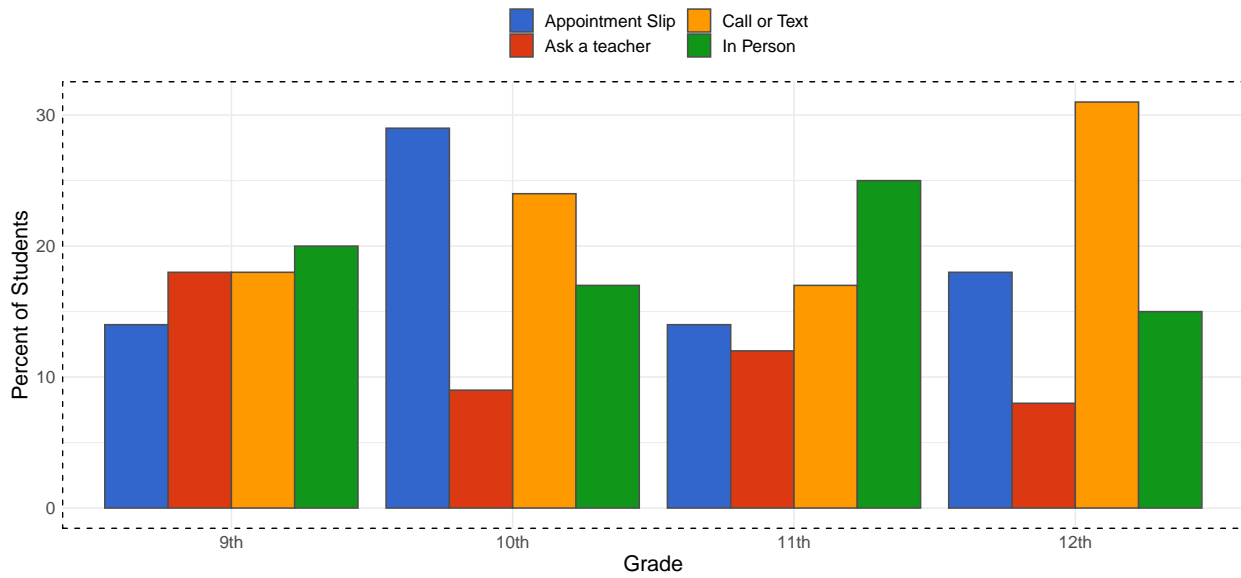
Number of Respondents from each grade



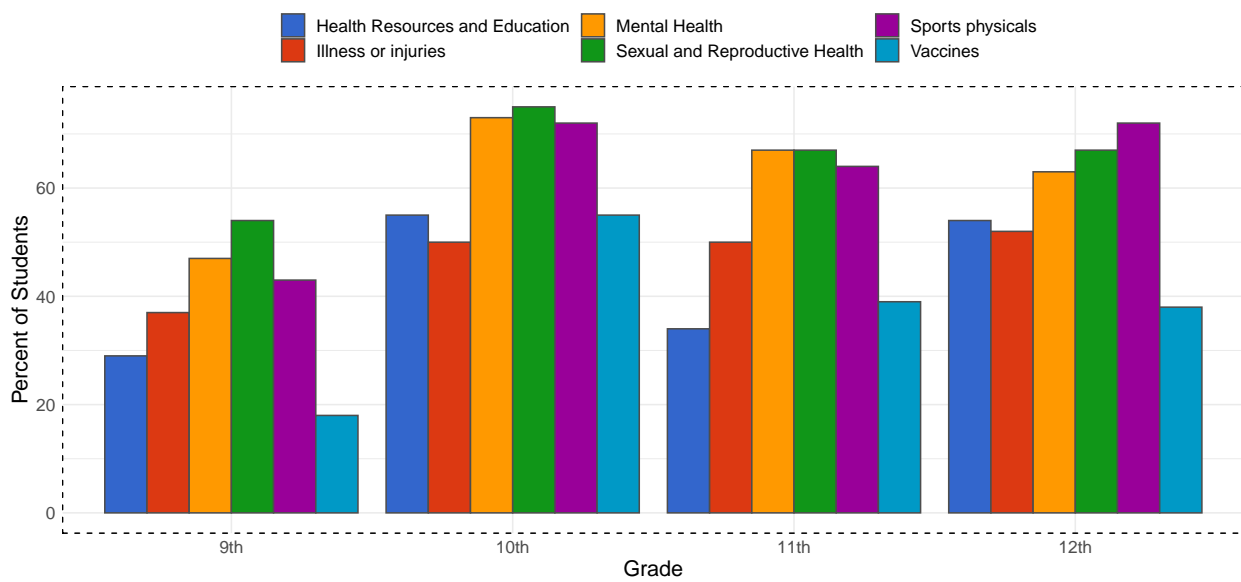
Did you know the SBHC existed before this survey?



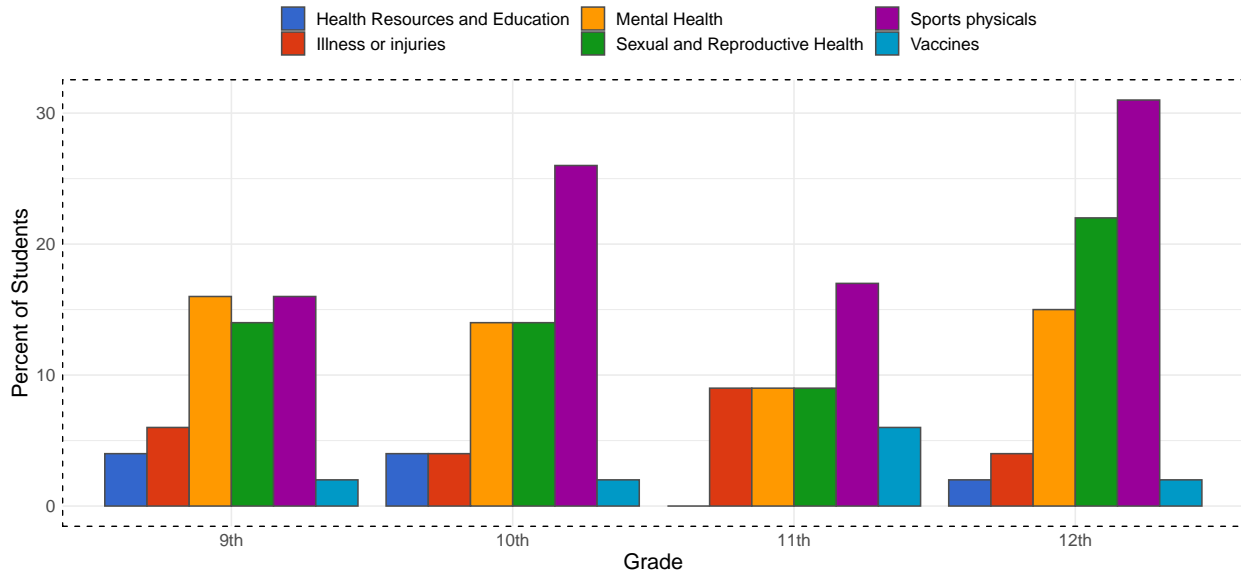
If you have been to the SBHC, how do you make appointments?



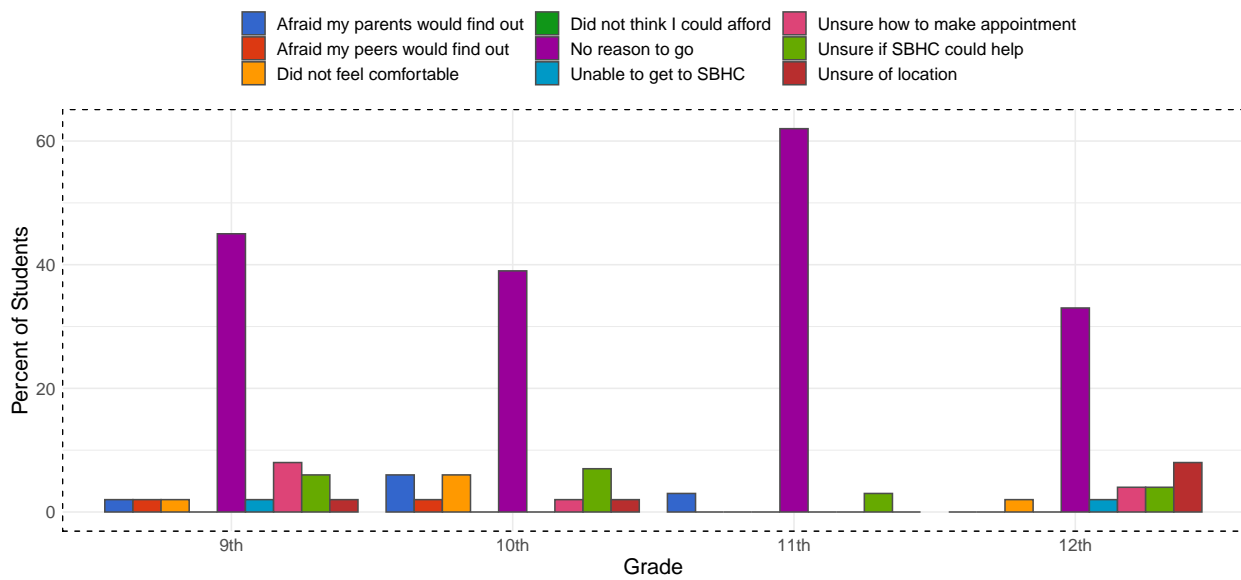
Are you aware of all the services that the SBHC offers? Select all that you have heard of:



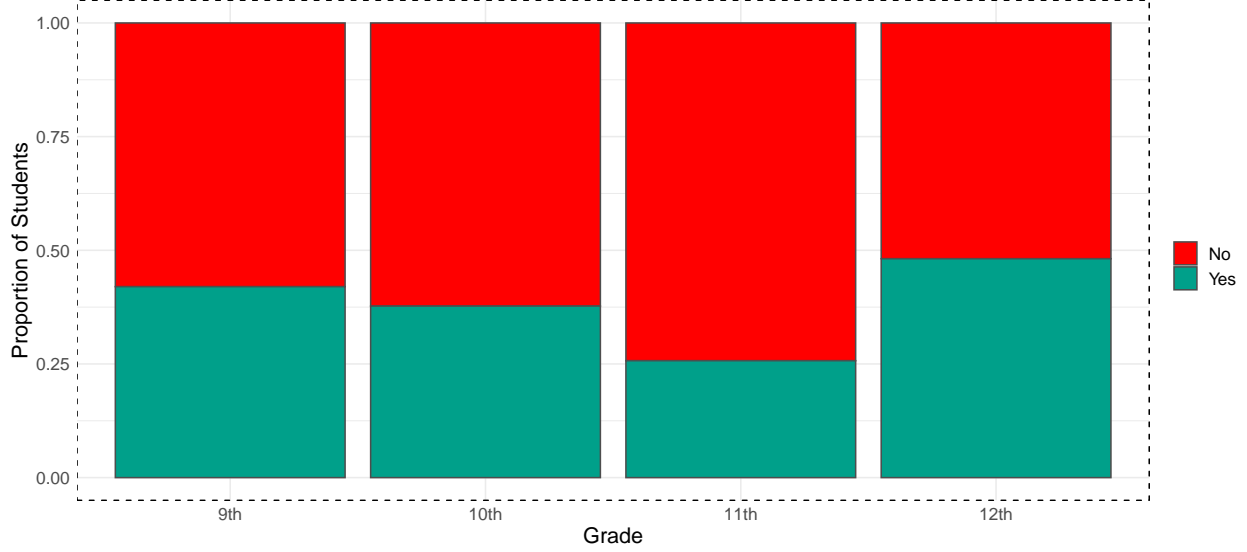

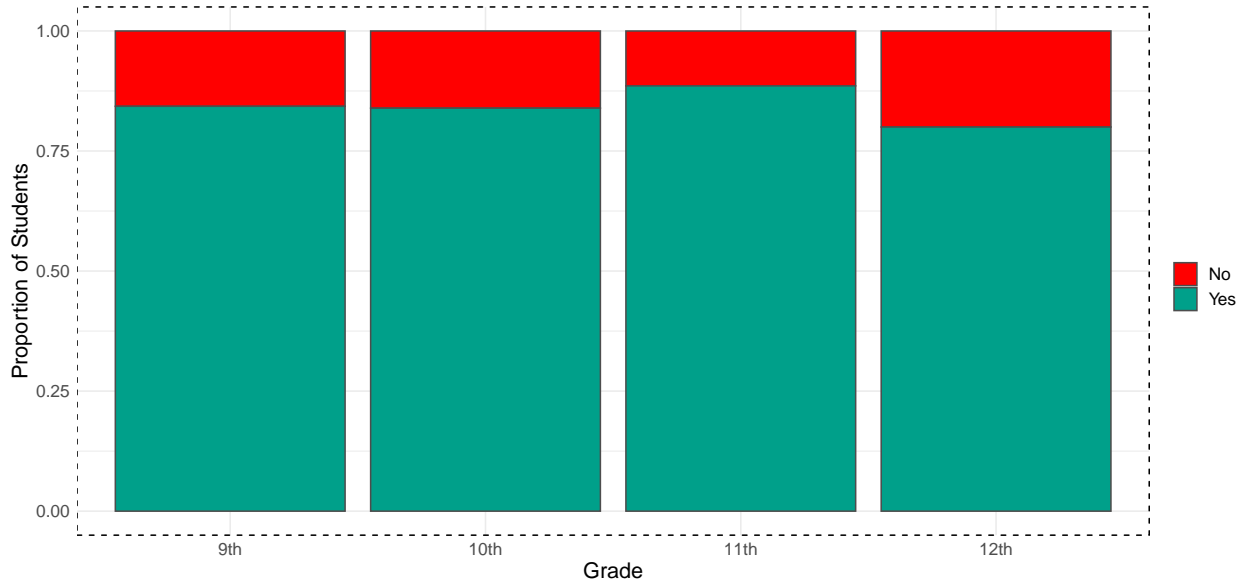

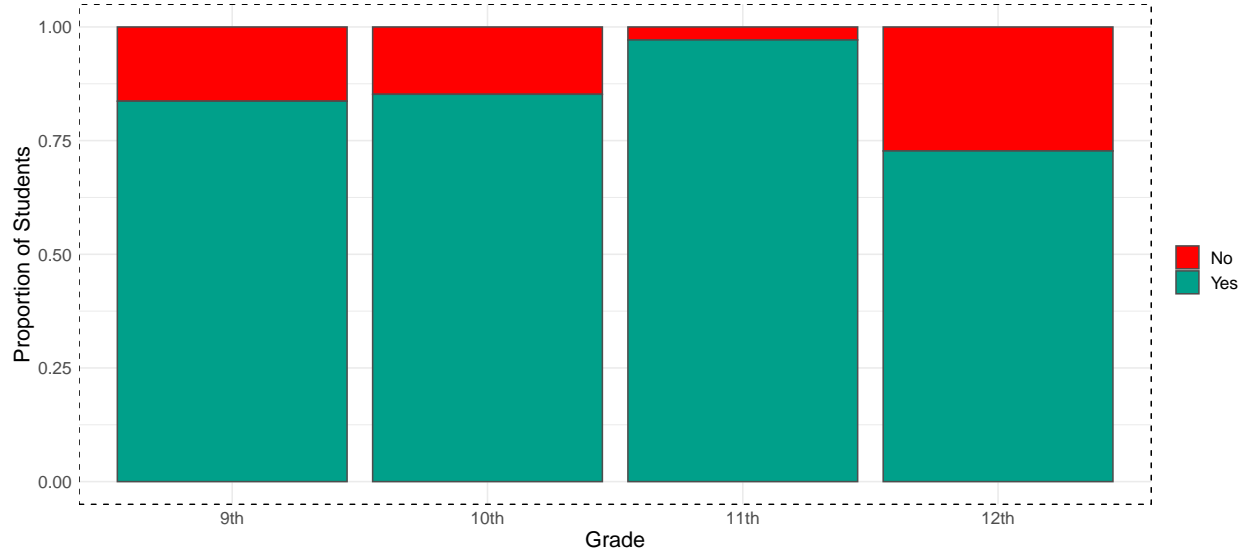
Did you know that most students in Washington State are eligible for Applehealth insurance?
(Applehealth is public, free or low-cost health insurance)



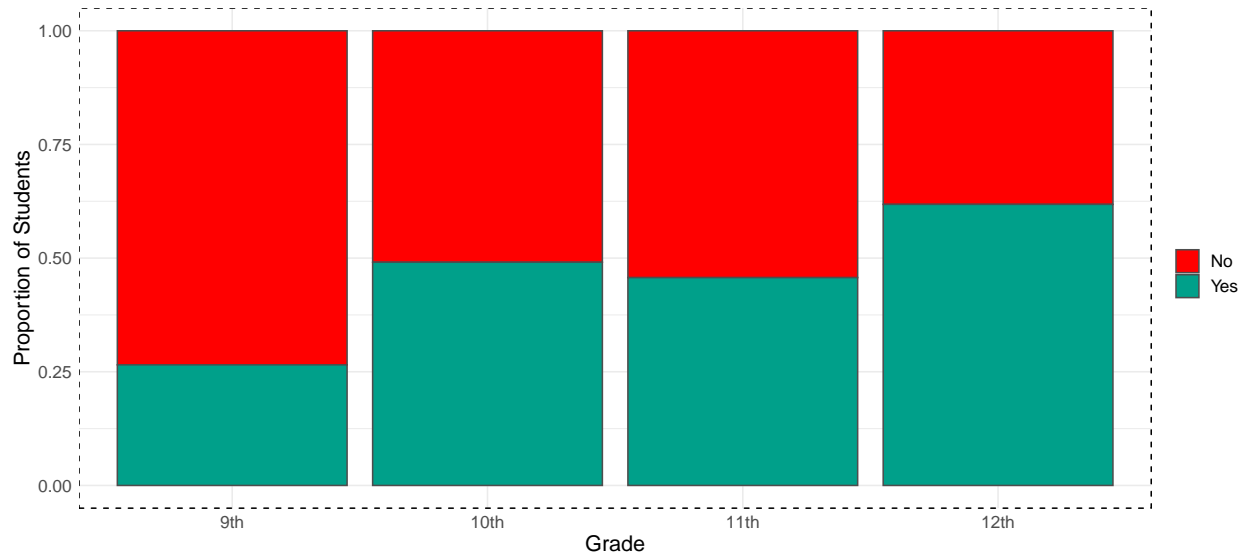
Did you know that people 13 year or older may receive mental health care without parent consent?



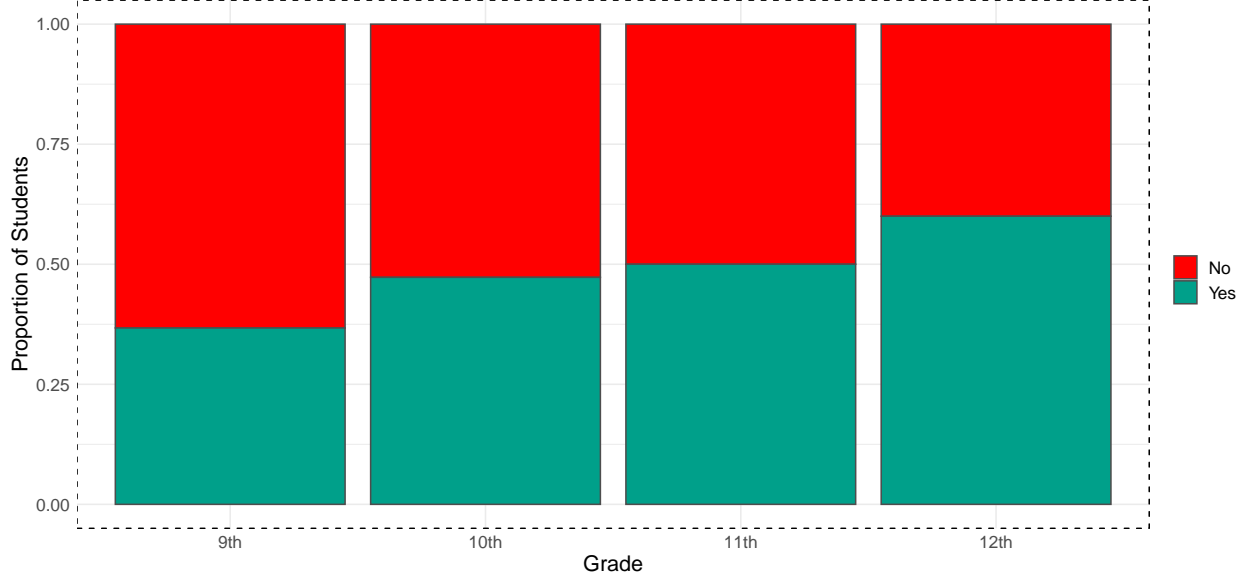
Did you know that students can receive birth control/reproductive health services at any age in Washington state without parent consent?



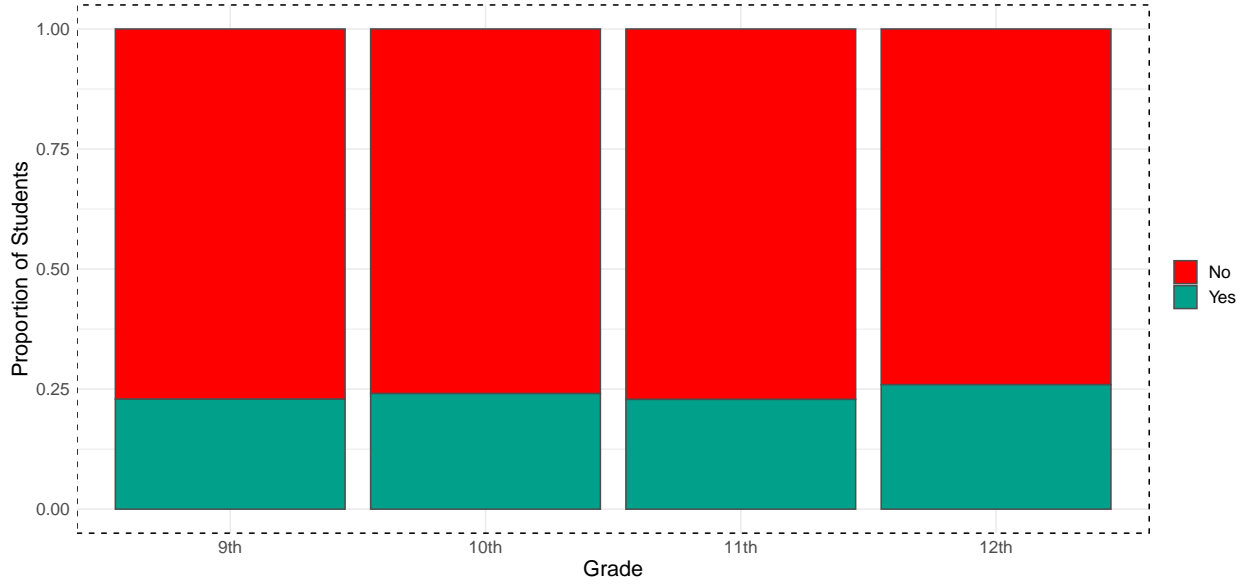
Did you know that the SBHC has private billing? (Private billing means appointments will not be charged to your parent/guardian's insurance if you don't want them to be)



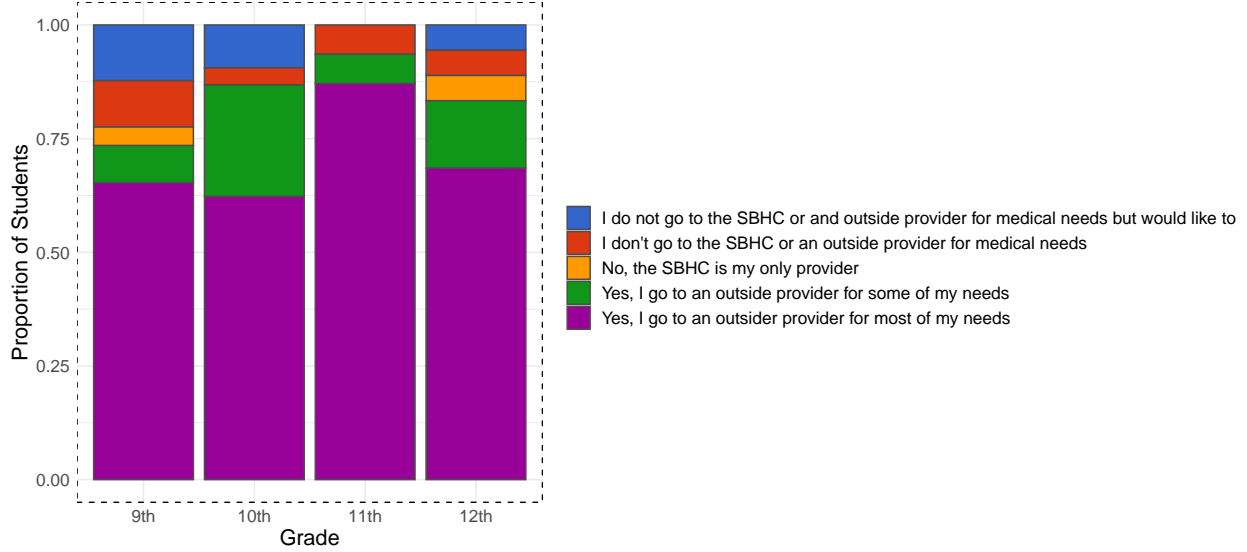
Did you know that the SBHC has a sliding scale/No Students Turned Away policy?



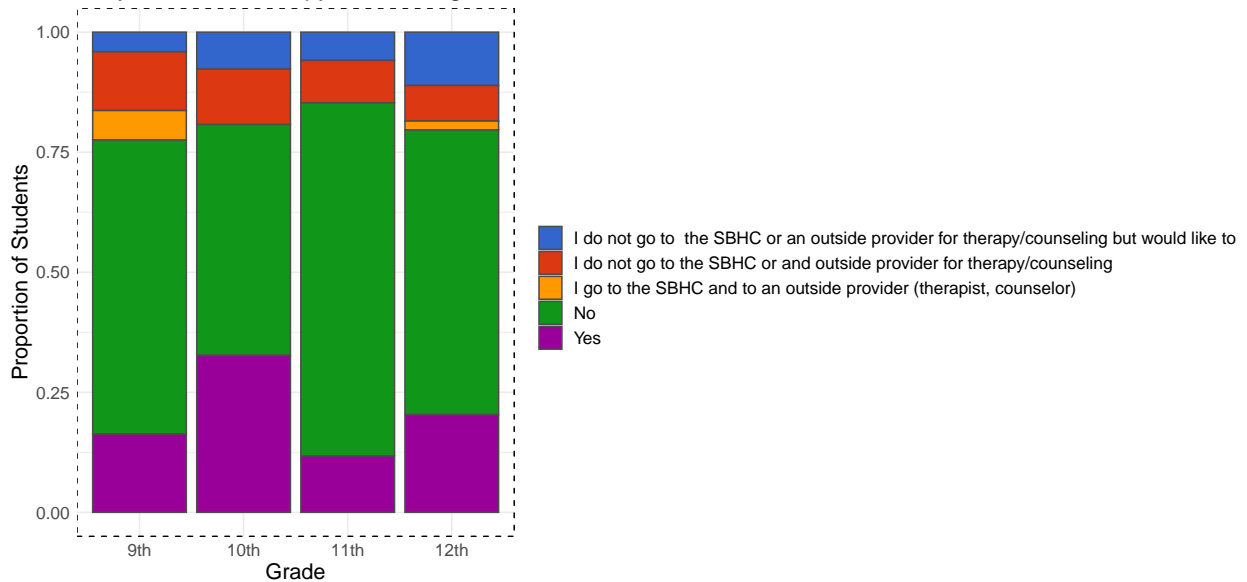
Did you know that the SBHC has translation services?



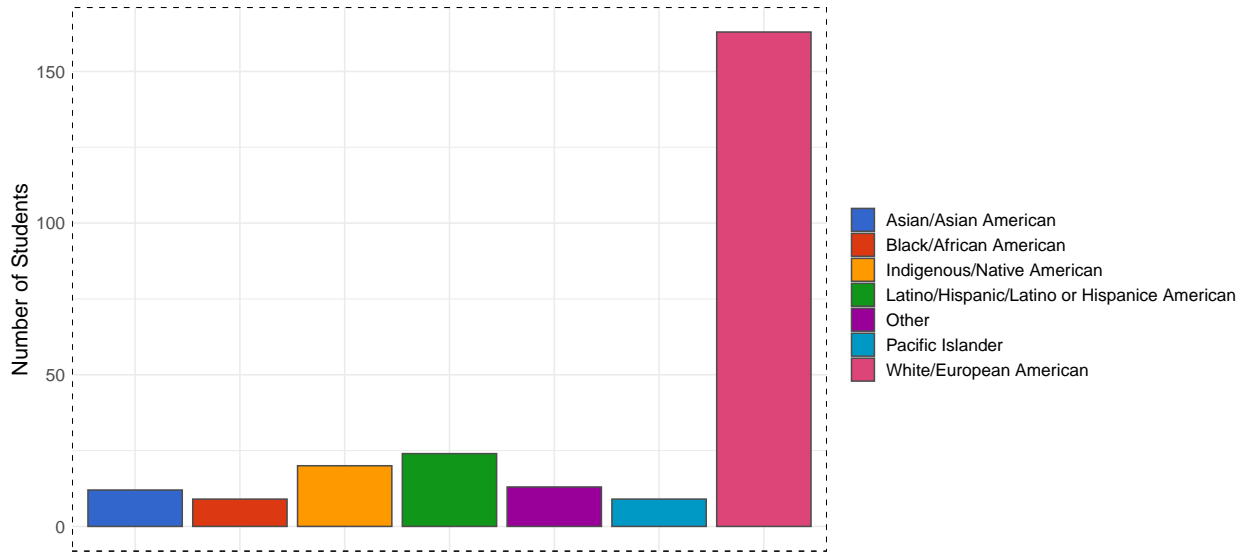
Do you have a medical provider outside of the SBHC? By provider, we mean a doctor, nurse practitioner, specialist, naturopath, etc.
